







“VIVERE” per Tito Schipa

“Vivere”, brano di tanti anni fa reso celebre da Tito Schipa, è il titolo dello spettacolo musicale con cui gli alunni dell’Istituto Comprensivo di Muro Leccese, diretto da Antonella Corvaglia, hanno reso omaggio all’indimenticabile tenore leccese nel 50° anniversario della scomparsa. Ospite d’eccezione della serata, tenutasi di recente nel teatro “La Bussola”, Tito Schipa jr., poliedrico musicista figlio dell’«Usignolo d’Italia», molto applaudito al termine di una breve e intensa performance artistica. L’iniziativa è stata molto apprezzata dal direttore del Conservatorio di Lecce Salvatore Stefanelli, con cui l’Istituto ha avviato una collaborazione per l’attivazione di laboratori musicali.

“Living”, a song of long ago made famous by Tito Schipa, is the title of the musical with which pupils of the Comprehensive Muro Leccese, directed by Antonella Corvaglia, paid tribute to the unforgettable tenor from Lecce on the 50th anniversary of his death. Special guest of the evening, which was held recently in the theater “The Compass”, Tito Schipa Jr., a versatile musician son of the “Nightingale of Italy”, warmly applauded at the end of a short, intense performance.

The initiative was very well received by the Director of the Conservatory of Lecce Salvatore Stefanelli, with which the Institute has entered into a partnership for the activation of music workshops. Among the dignitaries present, the regional councilor Salvatore Negro, Senators George Costa and Salvatore Ruggeri and mayors of the nearby towns.

The show was proposed by the choir of 70 young elements, accompanied on the piano by Marco Creti and directed by Maria Grazia Creti, with narrator actor and director Salvatore Della Villa: In the repertoire, religious music, lyrical and melodramatic. Tito, Jr. has admired the combination of the voices of the small choir with his father in the execution of “Living”. “The idea - he said - it was very simple, but the simple things are the ones that work best. There is much to discover on the talent and personality of Schipa senior, it is important to raise awareness among the younger generation, investing in the preservation of artistic and cultural Salento”. “Through this event - said the Headmaster Corvaglia - the figure of Tito Schipa, who in 1967 was named the middle school, is rooted even more in our institution whose identity is already strong, is evolving towards innovative scenarios”.
